- The 4th EIPEN conference The 4th EIPEN conference took place in Slovenia in the lovely city of Ljubljana and was hosted by the Faculty of Health Sciences at the University of Ljubljana. The conference was chaired by Professor Majda Pahor and supported by her colleagues in the Faculty. There were 55 participants from 16 countries and from three continents. CAIPE had a strong representation of nine people all presenting papers, doing workshops and actively participating in the EIPEN members meetings. The conference provided opportunities to share knowledge and experiences, network and develop new contacts with colleagues working in the field of IPE. It was a very enjoyable and sociable event. The social programme included a walk around Ljubljana accompanied by a very well informed guide, who told us about the history and architecture of the city and the conference dinner which was held in one of Ljubljana's oldest restaurants. The venue for next EIPEN conference 2015 is to be announced later in the year. The full report will be posted on the website shortly.

The conference brings together providers, health system executives, educators, policymakers, and healthcare industry leaders to advance interprofessionalism in health care delivery and education locally, regionally, and worldwide. - A Survey of Pre-registration Interprofessional Education in the United Kingdom 2010-2012 This 'Survey of Pre-registration Inter-professional Education in the United Kingdom 2010-2012' was commissioned by the Higher Education Academy in 2010 and seeks to provide an up-to-date picture of inter-professional education (IPE), representing the responses of 52 educational institutions relating to 63 IPE courses or modules. The survey will be published later in 2013 by the Higher Education Academy as part of the review of IPE in the UK since 1997. Issues arising from this survey will be discussed with those from other research strands in the final report. - Changes proposed to pharmacy regulation. The General Pharmaceutical Council (GPhC) is working towards becoming the principal regulator responsible for pharmacy inspections. In the proposals, the GPhC will be responsible for inspections, except in a series of tightly defined circumstances. This will be achieved through more joined-up working with a set of memoranda of understanding agreed between the GPhC, and the other regulators and authorities by the end of this financial year.
